

Essay for admission or essay "About yourself"

If you look at the whole process of admission to a British university, the list of documents and requirements, the essay can be confidently distinguished into a separate category. On the one hand, it is an ordinary essay "About yourself", but on the other - it is the main headache and cause of sleepless nights for the vast majority of British applicants. Often, they resort to the help of cheap essay writers who write essays for them in the shortest possible time. In our article we will understand this phenomenon, the reasons for its occurrence, as well as set out a simple step-by-step instructions for writing an essay.

For starters, what is an essay and why is it needed?

The essay (Personal statement) is a short written application of the applicant to the university professors, in which he should describe himself, not externally, but in terms of character, hobbies and skills, explain why he chose this specialty and not the other, and also indicate why he deserves the right to study at the university. In other words, an essay is a simplified form of interviewing, although some universities do both, but other articles do mention it.

Different universities have different approaches to essay writing. For less popular institutions (with little competition), it is more a tribute to tradition. For the more prestigious universities, an essay "About yourself" is as important to them as the academic results of an applicant. It is also logical! If there are few people willing to enter a particular university, the results of final examinations are enough. If the number of applicants exceeds the number of seats, there is a need for additional means of selection. Simply put, two students with the same grades and a set of subjects will choose the one who is more argumentative, and most importantly, more sincere, will prove that he has the necessary skills and qualities of character, and is worthy of this place.

The essay is shrouded in a host of myths. For example, that no one reads it and it is not worth bothering yourself too much, or, on the contrary, that it is a terrible and unknown letter, the secrets of writing which are known only to a few professors who for some reason are advertised on the Internet and take money for it. Many, unfortunately, fall under the influence of these scaries and are afraid of writing more than the final exams. Some guys already 2 years before graduation start thinking about it, collecting clippings from magazines, looking for examples on the Internet, planning, writing and many times rewriting essays, and, most importantly, are very worried about it. Every now and then, there are curious situations.

Representatives of the agency constantly participate in conferences on admission to universities, organized by UCAS, and every year representatives of different universities tell funny stories. Thus, for example, after the publication in the network of a story about a great chemist who in childhood, doing experiments, burned his pajamas with reagents, about 40% of applicants for the faculty of chemistry wrote the same in their essays.
